 There has been a 48% increase in the number of diagnosed from a baseline of 12,518 patients to a current level of 18,501.



3. There has been a **46%** increase in the number of PI patients receiving Immunoglobulin therapy from a baseline of **4,367** patients to a current level of **6,389**.



2. There has been a **36%** increase in the number of patients receiving some form of treatment from a baseline of **6,000** patients



4. There has been a **28%** increase in the number of PI patient referrals from a baseline of **14,173** patients to a current level of **18,135**.
